PEST CONTROL—WAREHOUSE, GLOUCESTER

THE PROBLEM

This large distribution centre, situated on the outskirts of Gloucester is responsible for hundreds of deliveries per day to public houses, hotels and restaurants throughout Wales, the West of England and Oxford.

A problem had developed with gulls colonising the roof of the building. The gulls were causing damage to the roof as well as creating a health hazard due to fouling.

During very heavy rainfall during the summer months, the gull breeding season, debris from nesting and feeding was being washed from the roof into the gutters causing the gutters to block. This resulted in the gutters and downpipes overflowing and partial flooding of the distribution offices.

Immediate action was required to deal with the situation to prevent a re-occurrence. The Protectahome Pest Control team were called in to provide a solution.

THE SOLUTION

Protectahome's Surveyor carried out an extensive survey of the building and drew up a specification of Bird Proofing work.

The Proofing employed a 75mm Gull net, fully UV light stable and rot proof. The net was suspended on stainless steel wires and fabricated steel poles across the entire roofs of the warehouses and distributions offices. The elevation of the net provides access beneath for building repairs and maintenance.

The Bird Proofing was carried out without the need for any closure of the building or the distribution yard, meaning that the client was able to go about their business without interruption. Protectahome's work prevented re-colonisation of the roof prior to the beginning of the breeding season.
